There are three main ways that a student may wish to study in Britain. For those who have successfully completed at least two years of higher education study in their own country, they can apply to study in England for one year to obtain a bachelor's degree:

- Top-up - usually a course designed for a single year of study and sometimes created specifically for overseas students. These courses generally assume a general knowledge of the subject area and operate a steep learning curve in the first few weeks to reach university level
- Year 3 Entry - students join the third year of an existing three year course. This type of entry can prove more challenging, because the student will need to have a good knowledge of what has already been taught in years 1 + 2 and will be joining an established group of students.

Those students who are about to leave school, or who have never studied at higher education level, should apply for the normal three year course.
