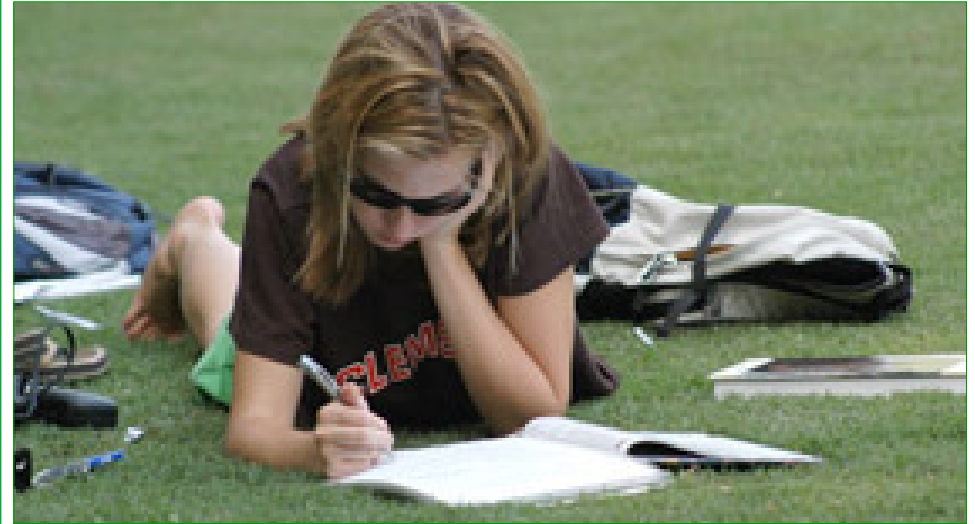

## FEES

Fees are c£3,200 per annum. This is only repayable, in instalments, when the graduate is earning the equivalent of c£6,000 per annum or more in his/her own country;  
OR £15,000 or more if the graduate works in Britain.

## BURSARIES

Some universities award a bursary (grant) of up to £1,000, depending on family income. Look at our website for further information. A limited number of scholarships may also be available.

## GETTING A JOB

Lots of local opportunities  
Companies regularly employ students  
Limit work to no more than 20 hours per week  
Minimum wage: £4.77 to £5.73 per hour (depending on age)  
Use the employment agencies or the University's own Job Shop.

## WHAT STANDARD OF ENGLISH DO I NEED?

We recommend you obtain one of the following:

TOEFL - 550 points

IELTS - 6.0

Cambridge Advanced Certificate (CAE)

London Chamber of Commerce (Level 3)

You will need one of these qualifications (or equivalent)

### **OR**

Some universities may be willing to accept you if you can show your proficiency in English when submitting your application.
