### TAKE A CLOSER LOOK AT CRIME!

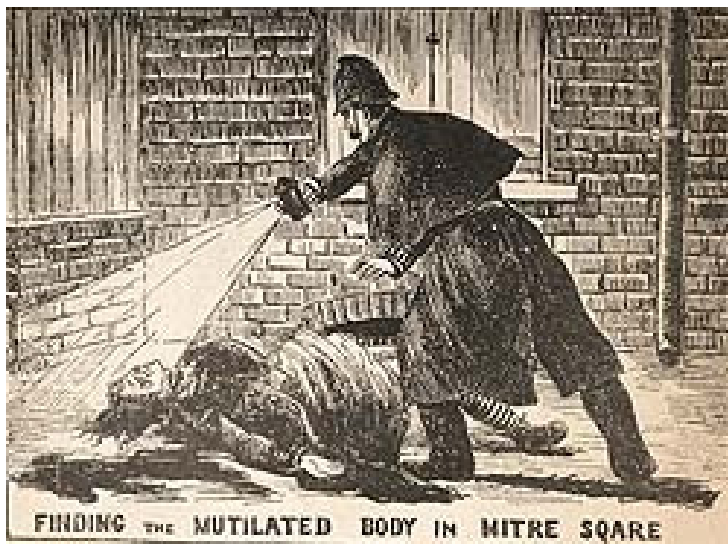
This September, Huddersfield University will be offering a new honours bachelor's top-up degree in Criminology and International Politics. Students of social sciences (Psychology, Sociology, Politics etc) may apply, even if they have never studied criminology before.

Criminology has become a very popular area for study in England, with student numbers rising rapidly. Why? We all seem to have a great interest in crime (think of the number of detective programmes on television!) and it is, after all, part of our daily lives. Course Leader Antony Whitehead says the study of Criminology "applies a considerable range of academic disciplines as diverse as human geography, politics, psychology and anthropology to the complex and shifting problem of crime and crime prevention... We combine Criminology with International Politics so that students may better understand the relationship between national and international forces which shape crime and national and international crime-control policies."

### WHAT CAN I STUDY IN ENGLAND?

Almost every degree course in the seven universities we represent is available for you to study:

\*Top-Up: Complete at least two years in your own university, then study in England for one year to obtain an honours degree.

\*Third Year Entry Join the third year of an existing course and obtain an honours degree in one year

\*Three Year Course Study a complete degree course in England over a 3 year period

\*Master's Degree If you already have a good degree and excellent English, study 1 year in England+ 1 term at home to complete your dissertation
