These universities will always require a language qualification:

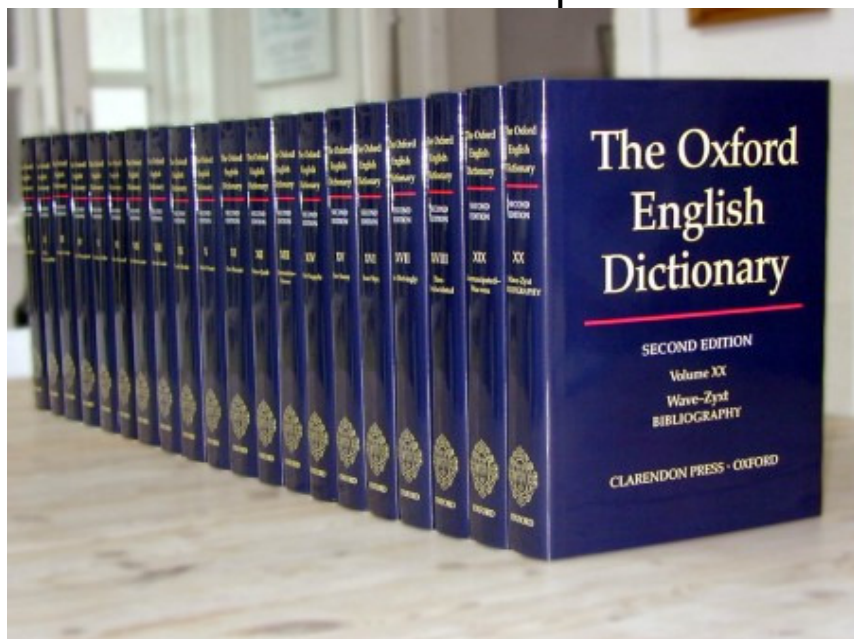
Birmingham City
